THE BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY (BSPS) SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW Affiliation Number 699

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover, either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards, no check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they compete. Members/guardians are responsible for ensuring the manufacturer's guidelines with regard to fit and replacement are followed. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championship shows, Royal International Horse Show, London International Horse Show, Burghley Gold Cup and lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)

In WHP classes riders must wear body protectors (rule 50).

Body protectors <u>MUST</u> be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including practice ring at BSPS. Affiliated Shows (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all BSPS. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label.

BETA recommends body protectors are replaced every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

Ponies must not have qualified for the 2024 Horse of the year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for The BSPS Challenge.

BSPS BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR 1st and 2nd placed ponies will qualify in the following classes: Open L/R, F/R, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony and Open Intermediate SRT, SHT and WH.

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form**. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

RIHS Amateur Qualifying Classes 33-36 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rule 6 &7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

The highest placed unqualified exhibit in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2024.

The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2024. The BSHA offer a Novice, Amateur and Young Rider Rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse). The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year. **Day Tickets** – Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse per Rider per season. At Midland Counties Show a Day Ticket will allow entry into the Open Working Show Horse, Amateur and Novice classes only, but will not allow entry into RIHS & Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form or apply online on the BSHA website. **Classes 16, 45-48 will be open to members & non-members of the BSHA.**

The two highest placed horses in the top five, not already qualified will qualify for the Final. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members, or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket, Riders 15 years old and over. **For full rules and eligibility see BSHA rule book.** Fences: min. 2'9, max. 3'0, spread 3'0.

BSHA RISING STAR ASSOCIATE SERIES Open to members and non-members. See BSHA rule book.

COLOURED HORSE AND PONY SOCIETY (UK)

This show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) Show Affiliation No. 23-120

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid Qualifier card. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 15th–17th August 2024 . All Stallions 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS (UK).in order to Compete in these classes and MUST wear their stallion Discs without exception.

Classes 80–83 and 170–176 are CHAPS (UK) qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members Handbook or visit: www.chapsuk.com. for rulings.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW 2024 Qualifiers Classes 173-176.

These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, October 2024. Qualification will not pass below 5th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office. This competition is open to mares, geldings and CHAPS (UK) graded stallions, four years old or over, to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of the stud books of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society CHAPS (UK) or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA). All Stallions MUST wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception in order to compete. All Riders and Owners must be members of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society, The Showing Register or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association.

For height restricted exhibits a valid JMB number must be lodged with the respective society. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show Rule book, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk and competitors must make themselves conversant with these rules before entering these classes. This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. All Horse of the Year Show qualifiers run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk . Qualification for Horse of the Year Show will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

In Horse of the Year Show Qualifying Classes, all data given upon entry of these classes will be provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit: www.grandstandentries.com. Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

NCPA PONY OF THE YEAR

1st & 2nd prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify for NCPA Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, 1st September 2024.

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY (NPS)

NPS M&M QUALIFYING ROUNDS To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS Competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but ONLY ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th–8th August 2024. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify For the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's membership card to be shown in the ring.

NPS/SHOW PONY & SHOW HUNTER PONY QUALIFYING ROUNDS To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony Studbook sections or the Ridden Register: The GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony Studbook sections or the Ridden Register. Ponies must be plaited. Classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years old and over. Qualifying open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members, but ONLY ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th–8th August 2024. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's Membership card to be shown in the ring.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life Member** of the NPS.

A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership. card is not immediately produced; the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion pony provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS and has the required membership card in their possession. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home-Produced Ridden Championship

Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in the classes where this is indicated. These ponies if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders in Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by M P GLOSS PRODUCTS UK LTD. The Champion and Reserve from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland In-Hand will qualify for the final to be held at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show on Monday 28th August 2024. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

ROR TATTERSALLS SERIES

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series

The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final.

Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23rd 2024

RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a voucher for a RoR branded prize to the winner. Voucher to be redeemed from the RoR Office. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024.

Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.

Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st, 2024.

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.

Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season.

A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

Tattersalls RoR Former RACEHORSE CHALLENGE 2024

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be Competition Registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB or been IN TRAINING in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series

The first four go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree, August 24th 2024. The Judge will NOT ride.

Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the Judge.

Horses must hold a current RoR competition membership.

Tattersalls RoR NOVICE Ridden Show Series (1st,2nd and 3rd placed) to qualify for the final at Aintree August 24th 2024, shows after the 31st July 2024 to qualify for final in 2025. Horses to be ridden by the judge in this class.

Tattersalls RoR Former Racehorse Challenge, all show classes (1st, 2nd and 3rd placed) from 1st August 2024 to 31st July 2025 will be awarded qualification for the championship at The Jockey Club National Show at Aintree on 24th August 2024. Shows after the July 2024 will qualify for the final 2024. The judges will NOT ride in this class. (There will be a reduced number of qualifiers for this class from August 2024)

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series class, all show classes (1st, 2nd and 3rd placed) from 2nd June 2024 to 31st May 2024 will be awarded qualification for the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23rd 2024. Qualifiers held on or after June 3rd 2024, will qualify for the final 2025.

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden classes are amateur produced and ridden only. The judges in this class will not ride horses in the qualifiers but the judges will ride in the final.

Tattersalls RoR Open In-Hand Show Series (1st, 2nd and 3rd) to qualify for the final at The Jockey Club National Championships at Aintree August 24th 2024. Shows after 31st July 2024 to qualify for the final in 2025. This is an In-hand class only.

SHB(GB)

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) passports or over stamped passports can enter classes 9-10 & 16. Owners & riders need to be current members of SHB(GB) or compete on a day ticket. Class 8 Horses, owners & riders can be registered with SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR. Classes 65-67, 74-76 & 77-79 Horses need to be passported with SHB(GB) or have overstamped passports Owners do not need to be members of SHB(GB) or can compete on a day ticket.

Qualifying Classes for Ridden and Working Hunter Championships must also have a Show Hunter Registration Number & this must be quoted on all entry forms. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being on the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in any qualifying classes for the remainder of the season.

Competitors may compete on a day ticket £42 and may have a maximum of two day tickets per season at £42 each. Each day ticket is valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/ over stamp for that show.

If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/ over stamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Definition: Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

The Society designates certain Shows as qualifying shows for the RIHS at which horses may qualify for the RIHS in the current year or at specific shows for the following year. At these Shows the two highest placed horses in the Lightweight Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there is a Working Hunter Championship made up of the first and second prize winners from the light and heavyweight working hunter classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS unless they have already done so. Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest

placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. Judges must place all horses to determine qualifiers.

SHETLAND PONY STUD BOOK SOCIETY

Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show. In order to enter a stallion class at an affiliated show, entire males aged 4 years old must have an "s" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS voluntary veterinary examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand colts/stallions 2 years and over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a stallion bridle disc available from the SPS-BS.

4) There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years may not show colts (excluding foals) or Entire males in In-Hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In The interests of safety. Hard hats of the current safety standard must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-Hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard Hats must be worn by all exhibitors irrespective of age in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4years old and over. In ridden Classes if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY:

This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society Affiliation No AF000036 and offers qualification for **THE NATIONAL WELSH CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** on the 11th August 2024 at the Three Counties Showground Malvern. Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards. See Sections relevant to registered Welsh breeds (In Hand & Ridden) for qualification details. Qualifiers will be directly contacted after this show with details of qualification and entry details. Exhibitors shall be solely responsible to ensure they are insured to cover any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread of any infection or contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the Showground by him or her and shall indemnify Midland Counties Show and its Officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries in the Show.
- 16. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibits shall do so in writing to the Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the sum of £50.00. The protest shall be considered by an agreed Panel, the members of which have been elected by the Midland Counties committee. If on investigation the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited. All protests not delivered within an hour of the incident will not be considered.
- 17. Exhibitors Risk and Responsibility

Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss or injury, or damage done to or

commissioned by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him or her and shall indemnify the Show against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and animals on the showground or elsewhere which is his/her own, or for which he/she is responsible. Exhibitors should effect Employers Liability Insurance where this is required by statute.

18. Health & Safety

The safety of competitors, animals, show officials and the general public is of paramount importance to Midland Counties Show. Horse walks and pedestrian areas have been clearly laid out by Arena UK and it is imperative that ridden, and in-hand horses and ponies keep within these designated routes when moving around the showground. Pedestrians should keep out of Horse walks and take guidance from Officials or Stewards at crossing points, etc. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to comply with any Health and Safety requirements placed on them whilst competing at the Show and to follow any instructions by stewards or officials. Any exhibitor who fails to comply with health and safety requirements or legislation may be liable to prosecution by HM Health & Safety Executive

- 19. **Conduct of Exhibitors and their Attendants:** Any act of discourtesy to any judge, steward, Show Official or Show Organiser on the part of any exhibitor or their attendants, will at the discretion of the injured party, disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited and the exhibitor may be ejected from the Showground. Competitors are reminded to be courteous to each other. Unsportsmanlike or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated at Midland Counties Show and should be reported immediately to a steward or other official.
 - Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their grooms or assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such servants or assistants and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the judge, steward, show official or member of the Midland Counties Show Committee.
- 20. In the event of a Veterinary Surgeon advising the removal of any animal from the Show his decision shall be final and immediately complied with.
- 21. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs in connection with any Veterinary Treatment given on the Showground and must be settled at the time with the Veterinary Officer concerned.
- 22. Horses and ponies may be measured at the discretion of the Judge unless in possession of a valid J.M.B. height certificate.

All dogs must be kept on leads and under proper control at all times.
